

Labeling Comments:

Per EPA letter dated April 29, 1999, under the label comments you must compile as follows:

In listing the organisms against which this product is effective you must capitalize the genus name. (Example: Thermoactinomyces vulgaris, Pseudomonas effusa...).

Under the "Precautionary Statement" place the statement "Harmful If 2. swallowed" after "statement" Do not get in eyes or on clothing.

3. Revise the" First Aid Statement" by deleting the current text and replacing with the following:

IF IN EYES:

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes, then continue rinsing.
- Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN:

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- Call a Poison Control Center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED:

- Call a Poison Control Center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a Poison Control Center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.

4. You may retain the "Note to Physician".
