This is to acknowledge receipt of your amendment to revise your directions for use for the above referenced product. This amendment is acceptable subject to the following conditions.

Make the following changes to this label.

1) The "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" statement must precede the signal word "DANGER" and be placed on a separate line. The word "Corrosive" must be deleted from this statement. The signal word "DANGER" must be placed on the following line and the type should be bold and a larger font.

2) In listing the organisms against which this product is effective you must capitalize the genus name. (Example: Thermoactinomyces vulgaris, Pseudomonas effusa...)

3) Your product must have a section with the subheading "Storage and Disposal". This section must be formatted as follows: (This format will be allowed due to the small size of your product container.)

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
PESTICIDE STORAGE: PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:

Your current "Disposal" statement is acceptable. The "Pesticide Storage" statement must read as follows. "Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children. If you are not in agreement with this statement you may refer to PR Notice 83-3 for guidance in developing a pesticide storage statement. Your revised statement should then be resubmitted to the Agency in the form of an amendment.

4) Revise your "Directions for Use" to include the following statement. "Replace pouch when tablets have dissolved."

5) Revise the "Precautionary Statement" as follows. Change to statement which reads "Causes irreversible eye damage." to read "Causes irreversible eye damage and skin irritation." Change the statement which follows "Do not get in eyes or on clothing." to read "Do not get in eyes or on skin or on clothing." Remove the statement "Avoid contact with food."

6) Immediately preceding the "IF SWALLOWED" statement place the subheading "Statement of Practical Treatment" or "First Aid" in bold type. Then revise your statements to read as follows.

"IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.


IF SWALLOWED: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, eggwhites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol."

You may retain your "Note to Physician".

7) It has been noted that your "Ingredients Statement" is not on the front panel of your label. The Agency requires this statement to be on the front panel of the label unless the container is unusually small. You have registered a similar product in a small container for which the Agency allowed the Ingredients Statement to "appear prominently on another panel." Refer to Agency letter for 51219-3 dated 12/11/79. Since it is our understanding based on a conversation with you on 4/28/99 that this container is the same size as that of 51219-3, Actabs XX will be allowed to also place the ingredients statement on a panel other than the front panel of this label. Note that your ingredients statement must include the phrase "Total 100%"

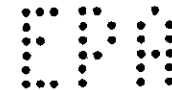

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Remove inner package containing tablets from outer plastic bag. Place the package, holes down and tablets facing up, into drain pan at a point as far from the drain hole as possible. Be sure that the single tablet at one end of the package is farthest from the drain hole. In extremely dirty pans it would be helpful to clean the pan before placing the package in the pan. The dirt might block the opening in the bottom of the package and inhibit metering of the ACTABS® XX. If there is any concern about the pouch being pushed to a hard-to-reach part of the drain pan, or if the drain hole is very large, tie one end of the cord to the grommet on the pouch, and affix other end to unit. Use one pouch for every seven square feet of drain pan area. The pouch should not be completely submerged. If necessary place a brick or similar object into the pan and place the pouch on top of it so that the top of the pouch is above the water level.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

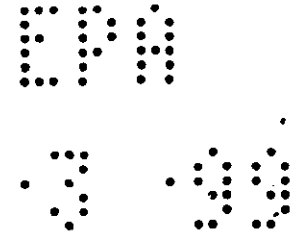
