Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Decision, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Label Comments

1. On page 1, replace the word “childproof” with “child-resistant.”
2. On page 1, under the Active Ingredient statement, list the common name “propoxur” in front of the chemical name.
3. On page 2, under the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section, move the last three sentences (i.e., “Do not contaminate...”, “Do not use...”, and “Do not remove...”) to the Directions for Use section, under the “General Information” heading. (See comment below about revising this heading).
4. On page 2, revise the heading “General Information” so it reads, “Use Information and Precautions.”
5. On page 2, under the Application Instructions, revise item 4 so it reads, “Replace all [12 or 8] roach discs every 3 months, or as needed, to keep roaches from returning.
6. On page 2, under the Storage and Disposal section, revise the heading “Pesticide Disposal” so it reads, “Container Disposal.”
7. On page 4, for the individual bait labels, add the common name “propoxur” to the Active Ingredient statement.

Remove all food sources and foods from areas where roach discs are to be placed. Use all [12 or 8] discs at one time for thorough roach control. Do not remove roach discs from box until ready to use.

Application Instructions:

- 1- Break individual discs apart from plastic frames (Graphic as pictured).
- 2- Place roach discs primarily in kitchen area and bathrooms. Also place near where roaches have been. Other areas might include the pantry, utility room, near exposed plumbing fixtures, windows and doors, under sinks, in corners, under stoves or refrigerators, in cabinets.
- 3- Roaches will feed on the bait and generally return to their hiding place to die.
- 4- Replace all [12 or 8] roach discs every 3 months to keep roaches from returning.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a dry, cool place. Keep in original container.

Pesticide Disposal:

Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container.

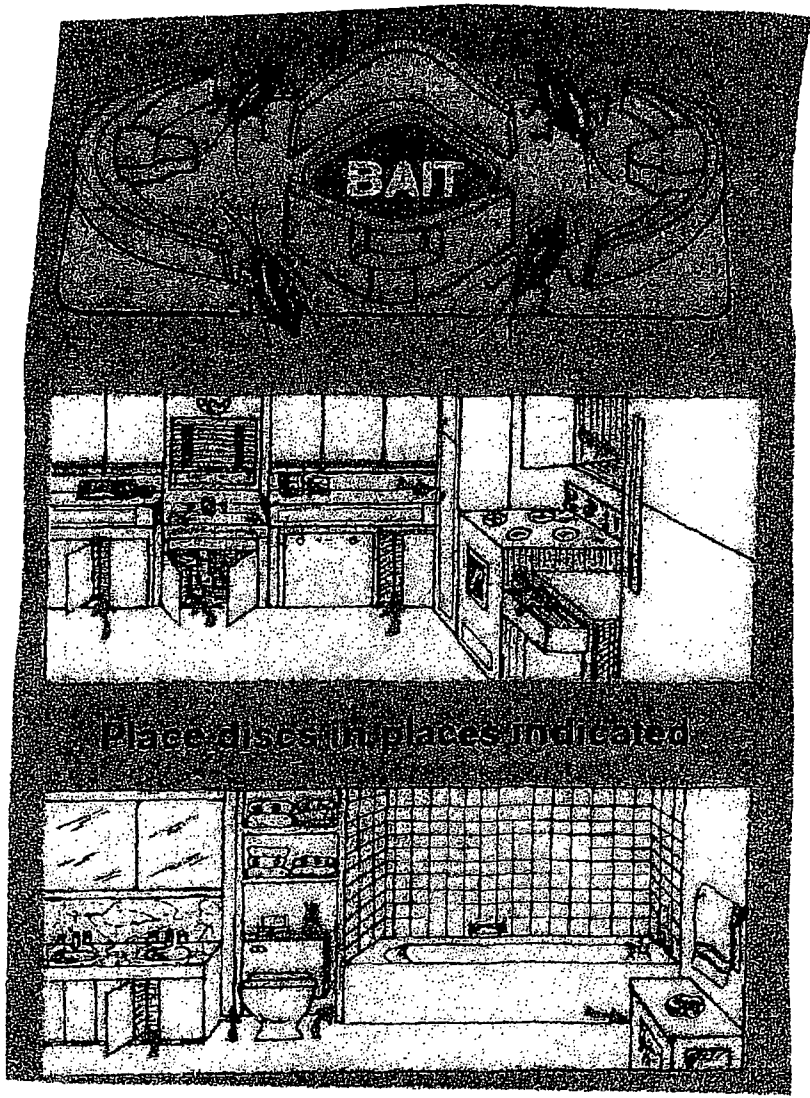
If Empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
