1. The registration number which has been assigned to this product must appear on the label as EPA Registration No. 51414-2
2. The Storage and Disposal statement must be appropriate for the container size. The following statement is suitable for container sizes one quart through one gallon for your type product.

Keep securely closed, away from heat or open flame in a well ventilated area away from food and feed. Fumes are corrosive to metal. Do not reuse empty container; rinse thoroughly with water and detergent. Discard in regular trash collection.

For containers larger than one gallon the following Storage and Pesticide Disposal statement should be used:

Storage and Disposal
