DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CALCULATION
For a new pool or for spring start-up, superchlorinate with one (1) pint (16 fl. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 2500 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE:

A. Add pool water pH to 7.6 - 7.2 range and maintain.

B. Add sodium hypochlorite by a feeder device sodium hypochlorite solution is a way to indicate an available chlorine residual of 0.60 ppm. One gallon of 6.00% sodium hypochlorite solution will treat 600 gallons of water will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequency of additions to maintain 0.60 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend on temperature and number of swimmers. Use test kit to make certain appropriate chlorine residual are in the proper range.
