DIRECTIONS FOR

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PWRCIDE-WSQ is used to control bacteria, algae, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slime, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 48 fluid ounces of PWRCIDE-WSQ per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 48 PWRCIDE-WSQ per 1000 gallons in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial dosages of 1.53 PWRCIDE-WSQ per 1000 gallons. Subsequent slug additions of 1.53 PWRCIDE-WSQ per 1000 gallons should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions should be made in the sumps. PWRCIDE-WSQ is used in air-washing systems that maintain effective misting to its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. An initial slug dose of 24.7 PWRCIDE-WSQ per 1000 gallons should be employed every 2 to 5 days. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Repeat initial dosages of 16.9 to 41.2 fluid ounces of PWRCIDE-WSQ per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 2 to 5 days. Frequency of addition depends upon the relative severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in collection trays of the airwash system.
