Subsequent slug additions of 1.7 to 10.2 fluid ounces of per 1000 gallons of water should be employed BioCon-102 every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water cooling towers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
