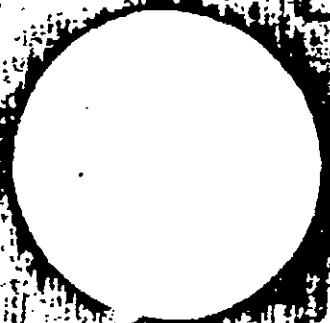

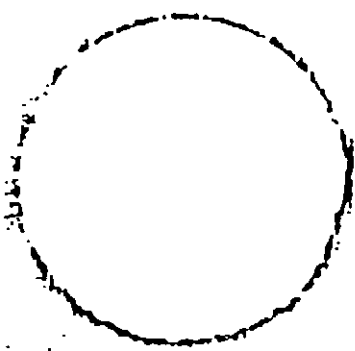

TWP protects wood substrates from premature loss of color, wood rot, surface mildew, and water absorption. The product contains powerful ultra violet light screening chemicals that prevent unsightly graying and loss of natural color. TWP is not intended for the control of termites or other wood destroying insects. TWP is available in 101 Cedar Tone, 102 Redwood, 103 Dark Oak, 104 Black Walnut and 100 Clear.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE. It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is for exterior use only and is not intended for use in direct contact with soil.

Rough Sawn Cedar, Wood Siding, Wood Shingles, Porch Decking, Fences, Shakes, Shutters, Facia.

Substrates: All wood surfaces. Due to variation of base wood colors finish color may vary from desired results. Check color by applying sample of product to determine desired effect.

New Wood: Wood must be dry before application. Apply on well-seasoned wood only after one year of weathering.

Old Wood: Unprotected old wood is typically various shades of gray to black. This is due to mildew and ultraviolet light attack on the wood surface. Remove mildew by power washing or scrubbing in conjunction with the following mixtures:

1 Qt. Household Bleach to 3 Qt. Water.

Rinse thoroughly and allow minimum 24 hours drying before applying. Surface must be totally dry to touch before applying T.W.P.

Previously stained wood: TWP is designed for application on clean wood surfaces. Applying this product over a sealed surface will result in a glossy film. TWP will function best if old finish is removed.

Spread Rate:

Apply at 300-500 sq. ft./gal. Rate will vary depending on wood porosity. Dry to touch 2-4 hours. Recoat over porous wood may be done immediately after application.

Method of Application: Use brush, roll or spray. Do not apply below 32°F.

Thinner: None required, use Mineral Spirits for equipment clean up.

Mix thoroughly before using.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE. Do not expose this product to excessive heat.

DISPOSAL:

Household Users: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

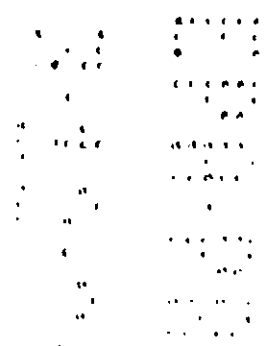
