

DIRECTIONS FOR

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

BIOCIDE C-160 is used in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and minimum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using BIOCIDE C-160.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of BIOCIDE C-160 fluid ounces of BIOCIDE C-160 to move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a pool add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces of BIOCIDE C-160 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of BIOCIDE C-160 per 10,000 gallons should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, or decorative fountains require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces of BIOCIDE C-160 per 1000 gallons of water. For treatment of a fresh hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 0 to 0.2 fluid ounces of BIOCIDE C-160 per 1,000 gallons of BIOCIDE C-160 should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment. BIOCIDE C-160 is composed of chlorine chemicals and is effective against algae. BIOCIDE C-160 can be used on swimming pools and spas and is effective against algae. However, do not mix BIOCIDE C-160 with liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and stored with clear water. All pesticides should be kept away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Vapors should be avoided.
