In the event of violation of use this product in accordance with its label.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

Mix the amount of material into 5 gallons of water. Add amount of material as needed for uniform mixing.

INITIAL DOSE:

Badly fouled systems before treatment is achieved initial dose is 3 ALGAE CONTROL, per 1000 gallons of water in the system. Residual is achieved.

SUBSEQUENT DOSE:

When microbial control is achieved, add 2 ounces of AQC-002, per 1,000 gallons of water every 2 days and repeat as needed to maintain a chlorine residual in the water with a chlorine test.
