GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

INITIAL DOSE

When the system is new, apply 4 1/2 to 8 pints of MICROBIOCIDE, per 1,000 gallons in the system (557-994) until control is achieved. Add material to makeup water for uniform mixing.

SUBSEQUENT DOSE

When microbial control is achieved, apply 2 to 4 pints of AQB-004 per 1,000 gallons of water (2-7-495 ppm) every 5 weeks to maintain control. Systems must be cleaned when is begun.

ENVIRONMENTAL

This pesticide is toxic if discharge effluent containing ingredient into lakes, streams, estuaries, oceans, or public water bodies. This product is specifically designed and addressed in an NPDES discharge effluent control to sewer systems without requiring the sewage treatment.
