

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FORMULA 843 is used

in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and innumerable effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using FORMULA 843.

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of FORMULA 843 per 10,000 gallons of water. For treatment of pools with settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of pools with heavy growth of algae add initially 12.8 to 23.5 fluid ounces of FORMULA 843 per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 4 fluid ounces of FORMULA 843 per 10,000 gallons of water should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 2 to 4 fluid ounces of FORMULA 843 per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially 1 fluid ounce of FORMULA 843 per 1,000 gallons of water.

For decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals and chemicals normally required. However, do not mix FORMULA 843 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

FORMULA 843 is compatible with chlorine chemicals and chemicals normally required. However, do not mix FORMULA 843 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
