Dear Ms. Stahl;

The Agency in accordance with the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as Amended (FIFRA) has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the aforementioned product in connection with the MGK® 326 RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable with the following label revision revisions:

1. The heading "HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" must be revised (fixing the typo as currently printed "HUMAN") and moved into the top cell of the red box, directly under the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS to read as follows:

"HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION: Avoid contact with"
2. Revise the "DIRECTIONS FOR USE" statement as follows:
 - a. Revise the last sentence of the first paragraph to read "Do not apply more than one (1) time per day." (as currently printed, the word "time" is not present).
 - b. Revise the last line of the black box by changing the word "larva" to "larvae", to indicate the plural, or alternatively, delete the entire word.
3. Revise the marketing statements above the DIRECTIONS FOR USE by deleting the misleading phrase "especially developed" and re-word to say "HAPPY HORSE is for

Use on Horses.”

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.


NOTE: This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA Sec. 4(g) at this time.

H & C Company, Inc. should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins.

HAPPY HORSE is formulated for HORSES.

HAPPY HORSE has been especially developed for Use on Horses. It provides a protective film coating against flies, while maintaining a high shine to the hair when brushed out. Use of one or two ounces per head per day gives adequate protection. Apply by rubbing a soft cloth or a fine mist spray. HAPPY HORSE is also a grooming aid and coat conditioner.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a lot easier to apply than most fly repellents. Apply liberally but do not overdo it. Do not use on horses or foals intended for slaughter. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly about the ears. Use only on horses or as a preventive spray in the stables. Do not apply more than one qt. per day.

APPLICATION TO HORSES

USE AS A WIPE ON: First brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Spray horse with a fine mist. Give special attention to the legs, shoulders, where neck and face where flies most often seen. After application, brush thoroughly with a comb to bring out bright shine on coat.

USE AS A SPRAY: First brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Spray horse with a fine mist. Give special attention to the legs, shoulders, where neck and face where flies most often seen. After application, brush thoroughly with a comb to bring out bright shine on coat.

APPLICATION TO STABLES

SPRAYING STABLES: Remove horses before treating stables. Spray stable with a fine mist. Do not apply to the point of saturation or runoff. Happy Horse kills and repels Stable Flies, Horn Flies, House and Face Flies, Horse Flies, Deers, Mosquitoes, Ticks, Fleas, Lice and Lice.

REMOVE HORSES FROM QUARTERS BEFORE TREATING PREMISES.

CAUTION: Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Prolonged or frequent repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.

FIRST AID: IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
