WC 610

in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems must be cleaned to remove algal and other deposits. An initial slug addition of

WC 610

per 1000 gallons of water is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved.

Subsequent slug additions of

WC 610

per 1000 gallons of water every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of additions should be made in the sump of water.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store more than five drums high. Drums should be opened in a well-ventilated area. Damaged drums should be placed in overpack and should not be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a container closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes, sludge, excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a separate waste stream and must be disposed of by use according to label directions. State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or its representative at your EPA Regional Office.
