DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOL CHLORINATION

For a new pool or for spring start-up, superchlorinate with one (1) pint (16 flu. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 2500 gallons of water. This dosage is equivalent to 5 ppm available chlorine by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE

- A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6-7.2 range and maintain.
- B) Add manually or by a feeder device, sodium hypochlorite solution at a rate to maintain an available chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One half pint (8 flu. ozs.) of sodium hypochlorite solution for each 6000 gallons of water will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight. Frequency of additions to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 ppm available chlorine will depend on temperature and number of swimmers. Use test kit to make certain the pH and chlorine levels are in the proper range.

NOTE: This product deteriorates with age. Use a chlorine test kit and maintain dosage as necessary, to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area away from direct sunlight. If a spill occurs, flush area with large quantities of water. Do not mix with acids. Dispose of unused product by returning to retailer or by burying in trash collection or burying in an appropriate area. Product residue that cannot be used, should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate food, feed, storage, disposal or cleaning equipment.
