DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General: Use House & Garden Spray to control cockroaches, waterbugs and other insects listed below. Apply coarse spray to localized areas where infestation may occur. Spray surfaces until wet.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets and Sowbugs: Spray areas where they may hide, including dark corners, cracks and crevices in walls; along window frames; behind and under refrigerators and cabinets and behind plumbing and other utility installations. Hiding places should be sprayed directly. Also around doors and windows. Else these pests may find entrance.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Use a spot treatment to infested areas of resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices behind baseboards, window and door frames, areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment with this product. Treat pets with one of our Tick Control products before allowing them on the area.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only to reduce annoyance from these pests on surfaces (window and door frames) where these pests may enter the home. Use on corners and localized resting areas on porches, patios and garages where they may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes on the surface will be killed. Repeat treatment as necessary.

STORAGE and DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat and flame. Store above 32°F.

Disposal: Do not re-use container. Before discarding in trash, wash container in several places and discard in trash.
