Dear Ms. Lanham:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. On Page 1 of the draft labeling, immediately above the ingredients statement, in the list beginning "For Use in Homes...", delete "and Food." (The product may not be used in food areas of commercial buildings because the label contains no directions for use in food areas, and the precautionary statements include the limitation, "Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas.")
2. On Page 3 delete the Environmental Hazards section because the label contains no directions for outdoor use. (Spraying the outside surfaces of buildings to reduce the annoyance of flies and mosquitoes is not considered to result in significant exposure of the environment.)

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General: Use House & Garden Spray as a spot treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below: Apply this product as a coarse spray to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.



To kill Cockroaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders and Sowbugs: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails; also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray pets with this product. Treat pets with one of our registered Flea and Tick Control products before allowing them to enter treated area.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) on porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surface will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Store above 32°F.

Disposal: Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Human: May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Do not allow children to contact treated surface until spray has dried. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Animal: Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow pets to contact treated surface until spray has dried.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes or ponds, streams, tidal marshes and estuaries. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

If On Skin: In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with plenty of soap and water. Thoroughly launder clothing before wearing again.

Note To Physician: Chlorpyrifos is a Cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, by injection, is antidote of choice.
