DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Continued)

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

Indoor Use: ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, FLEAS, BROWN DOG TICKS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES (exposed stage), TICKS AND WATERBUGS: Spray into cracks, crevices around baseboards, and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and in and around waste containers. Repeat as needed. Do not spray food-stuffs or house plants. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Do not allow children to contact treated surfaces until surfaces are completely dry.

BROWN DOG TICKS, FLEAS: Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do not spray animals.

For Crevices and Cracks: ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS, EARWIGS, BROWN DOG TICKS, FLEAS, CARPET BEETLES, AND DERMESTIDS: Apply diluted spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air.

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS IS NOT PERMITTED.

Outdoor Use: ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS, MILLIPEDES, SOWBUGS, AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray infested areas thoroughly, including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insects may enter. For ants, spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation.
