To control cockroaches, ants and silverfish: apply liberally, scattering under and behind refrigerator, stove, sink, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer, tubs, into openings around drains, sewers, manholes, water pipes and electrical conduits, in cracks and crevices along baseboards and in corners of cabinets, cupboards, and closets. Remove all lower drawers in kitchen and bathroom cabinets, bedroom dressers and chests of drawers, then scatter liberally in drawer wells.

Reapply as necessary. Any powder visible after application must be brushed into cracks and crevices or removed. Apply only in areas inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

Directions for Applying in New Construction to Control Cockroaches: When treating large areas, such as wall voids, soffit and subcabinet voids in new and existing construction, dust liberally using dusting application equipment.

Directions for Applying as a Major Solution to Control Cockroaches: Add 8 ounces of powder to each gallon of rinse water. Apply to floor areas only. Make only enough for each application.

Directions for Applying in Sewers to Control Cockroaches: Apply 16 ounces of product in sewer using dusting application equipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (CONTINUED)

CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT

Feed and Feed Handling Establishments other than private residences in which export feed is held, processed, prepared or served.

FOOD AREA APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY

Includes areas for receiving, storage, packing, bottling, wrapping, boxing) prepare waste storage and enclosed processing areas as mills, dairies, bakeries, restaurants or food or feed is stored, processed, prepared. Serving areas (when food is exposed and operation) also would be considered a food area. Apply in small amounts directly into cracks using a bulbous duster or other instrument capable of applying insecticide into cracks and crevices, in points between elements of construction, between equipment openings leading to voids and hollow spaces, equipment legs and bases, conduits, motors and electrical switch boxes where cockroaches are likely to harbor. Care should be taken to avoid depositing onto exposed food and feed, on hanging, and serving surfaces or introducing into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food surfaces.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN AND FEED AREAS OF FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS, OTHER THAN AS CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT, ARE NOT PERMITTED

Serving Area Facilities: places where products are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding where foods may be prepared or held. Apply as a spot treatment to selective surfaces: baseboards, under elements of construction, cracks and crevices. Avoid treating surfaces be contacted by food. (Do not apply when operation or foods are exposed).

NON-FOOD AREAS: Includes garbage rooms, floor drains (to sewer entries and offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, bathrooms, mop closets and storage (after bottling).

Apply to baseboard areas, around voids, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, pallets and similar areas where insects may enter.

DISPOSAL
