1. The front panel of the label must bear the following:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

CAUTION

 Revise your existing precautionary statements beginning, "Caution: Avoid prolonged breathing xxx etc"., to read

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: CAUTION: Avoid breathing of smoke. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash hands thoroughly after handling. Harmful if swallowed.

3. A Statement of Practical Treatment must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement, however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for approval:

Statement of Practical Treatment

If swallowed - Call a physic an or Poison Control Center immediately.

Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting
by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not
