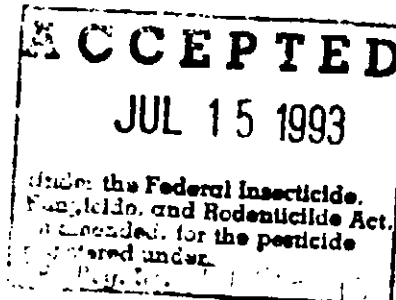

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product
in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using. Stir four (4) Tablespoons (2 fl. ozs.) of Dip Concentrate into one (1) gallon of water. Use rubber gloves. Dip, sponge or swab dog with the emulsion until thoroughly wet. Avoid allowing dip to enter dog's nose or mouth. Dipping should not exceed 30 seconds. Allow dog to dry in warm place without rinsing or toweling. Kills fleas, ticks, and mites on contact, but may require 24-48 hours to kill engorged ticks. Repeat application in 21 day intervals as necessary.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

WARNING

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not use on Cats. Do not use on bitches nursing puppies or puppies under three (3) months old. Do not use this product within 30 days before or after treatment with other cholinesterase inhibiting drugs or chemicals.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN AND VETERINARIAN

Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine by injection is antidotal only if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash off with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.
