The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Under the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals, please revise as follows:

CAUTION: Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not use on nursing kittens or puppies. Do not use on kittens or puppies less than 4 weeks of age.

- 2. Revise the NOTE TO PHYSICIAN as follows: Carbaryl is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine by injection is antidotal.
- 3. Base on the acute toxicity profile, the following Statement of Practical Treatment section must be added to the label.

IF SWA_LOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an

unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

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4. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement as follows:

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic organisms. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not contaminate when disposing of equipment washwaters.

A copy of the acute toxicity review is enclosed for your reference.

Submit three copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
