DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Spray infested surfaces until wet. Do not use as a space spray. On not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Remove pets and cover or remove fish bowts before spraying. Do not allow children to contact treated surfaces until surfaces are completely dry.

TO KILL: Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks, Indoors—Clean premises thoroughly before treatment. Treat the entire floor and carpet area. Special attention should be given to cracks, crevices and under carpet and rug edges. Also treat animal sleeping quarters, closets, upholstered lumiture (with particular attention to seams), beds, under solas and other furniture. In animal sleeping quarters, bedding should be cleaned or replaced with fresh bedding.

To avoid reintestation, pets must be treated simutaneously, with an E.P.A. approved insecticide labeled for use on animals. Application should be repeated as necessary. Humans and pets should avoid contact with treated surfaces (rugs, upholstered furniture, etc.) for 4 hours after treatment.

TO KILL: Fleas, Chiggers, and Ants, Outdoors—For treatment of localized infestation of these insects in outdoor areas, spray weeds and bushy non-crop areas around the home thoroughly Avoid spraying desirable plants. For arts, thoroughly wet hills and nurways. Repeat applications as reinfestations occur.

TO KILL: Aris, Crickets, Cockroaches, Silverfish, Spiders— Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark comers of rooms and closets, cracks, crevices, along baseboards, and door silfs and frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests flushed out of hiding should be sprayed directly. Treat ant trails, nests and points of entry.

Repeat treatment as necessary.

To fontrol house flies, gnate, hornete, moscutore, small/Clying poths, waspa and yellow jackets: the only on outdoor surfaces for a para outside surfaces of window and door frames and other areas where these peaks may enter the home. Also spray dark criers and localized resting areas, such as under eares, porches, partitions and in garages where these insects may congresse. 
