FOR SPOT TREATMENT

Indoor Use: ANTS, FLEAS, BROWN DOG SCORPIONS, SAW-TOOTHED STAGE), TICKS cracks, crevices around where these insects h cabinets, refrigerators, waste containers. Repeat stuffs or house plants where ants enter premises treated surfaces until surface. BROWN DOG TICKS, Fleas, pets, around baseboard cracks, and local areas of bedding should be placed. Do not spray animals.

For Cracks and Crevices: CRICKETS, SILVER FLEAS, BROWN DOG TICKS, AND DERMESTID amounts directly into cracks and local areas of bedding should be placed. Care should be taken to avoid exposed surfaces or intr
