

General: In the Home and Non-food Areas of Industrial Establishments: Spray surfaces to wetting. Point spray away from people and plants.... Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber or asphalt surfaces, such as tiles and floor coverings.

Indoor Use: ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, FLEAS, BROWN DOG TICKS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, SCORPIONS, SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES (exposed stage), TICKS AND WATERBUGS: Spray into cracks, crevices around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves and in and around waste containers. Repeat as needed. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Do not allow children to contact treated surfaces until surfaces are completely dry.

BROWN DOG TICKS, FLEAS: Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do not spray animals.

For Cracks and Crevice: ANTS, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SILVERFISH, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS, EARWIGS, BROWN DOG TICKS, FLEAS, CARPET BEETLES AND DERMESTIDS: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices, especially in points between different elaments of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air.

APPLICATION OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS IS NOT PERMITTED.

Outdoor Use: ANTS, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS, MILLIPEDES, SOWBUGS AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray infested areas thoroughly, including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios or other places where insects may enter. For ants, spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation.

To Kill Bees, Wasps, Hornets and Yellow Jackets: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and nesting places contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

For Control of Wasps and Hornets Outdoors: Apply after dark when all of the insects have returned to the nest. Remove cap, hold can upright, aim valve opening at nest and depress button, soaking nest with spray. When all wasps and hornets have fallen from the nest, destroy the nest. Repeat as necessary.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps and Flying Moths Outdoors: For outdoors, use gogly, as an aid in reducing anneyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated.
