

To kill ants, centipedes and crickets: Spray ed surface of patio or picnic area, hitting insects as possible. Spray ant hills and for best control. Repeat as necessary.

When properly directed, the spray mist will kill flies, mosquitoes and gnats up to 20 feet away valve opening away from face. For best results when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray from center of area to be treated when not breezy. Spray with wind if breeze.

Flies, mosquitoes, gnats and small flying moths: Close all doors and windows and spray all parts of the room with mist. Direct spray into all areas of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep the room closed for 15 minutes after treatment. Ventilate the room completely before re-entry. Repeat treatment as necessary.

DISPOSAL

Do not incinerate. Wrap container and put in collection.
