DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ON HORSES AND PONIES

Brush the animal thoroughly to remove loose dirt and dust.

BEST AVAILABLE COPY

Prepare the appropriate dilution in the amount required for immediate use (about one quart per horse). Diluted product should be used within 24 hours.

To Kill and Repel Horse Flies, Horn Flies, Gnats, and Mosquitoes:

Dilute 1 part concentrate with 14 parts water.

To Kill and Repel Horse Flies, Stable Flies, Deer Flies and Face Flies:

Dilute 1 part concentrate with 9 parts water.

Moisten (do not soak) a folded 12" square piece of turkish toweling with the dilution.

Rub against, then with hair growth. Give special attention to facial areas, neck, legs, shoulders and shanks where the flies are most often seen. Avoid contact with eyes or nostrils. Apply thoroughly to moisten hair.

If desired, the sheen of the coat may be enhanced by light brushing following application. For best results apply daily.

To Kill Flies and Lice:

Using a dilution of 1 part concentrate to 49 parts water, apply enough spray to thoroughly wet the skin of the animal. Repeat treatment as necessary. To help in prevention of reinfestation, thoroughly spray premises and sleeping quarters, paying particular attention to cracks and crevices.

To Kill Attached Ticks:

Saturate a cloth with this concentrate and dab directly on ticks. Avoid contact with eyes or nostrils.

IN HORSE BARN, STABLE AND TACK ROOMS

To control flies, mosquitoes and gnats, dilute at a rate of 1 part concentrate to 24 parts water or oil and apply as a fog or fine mist directing spray toward the ceiling and upper corners until the area is filled with mist using about 2 ounces per 1000 cubic feet of space. For best results, close doors and windows before spraying and keep them closed for ten to fifteen minutes. Ventilate the area and ventilate before reoccupying. Repeat application as necessary.
USE AS A WATER SPRAY

1-8 Dilution: Mix 1 quart of concentrate with 9 parts water to make 24 gallons of spray. Stir before using. Apply at the rate of 1 pint to 1 quart of dilute spray per animal depending on the size of the animal.

Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats: Apply as necessary to give continued protection.

Stable Flies and House Flies: Apply as necessary to give continued protection.

Horse Flies and Deer Flies: continued protection.

This dilution will kill horse flies, horn flies, mosquitoes, at the time of application.

1-14 Dilution: Mix 1 quart of concentrate with 14 parts water to make 24 gallons of spray. Stir before using. Apply at the rate of 1 pint to 1 quart of dilute spray per animal depending on the size of the animal.

Horn Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats: Apply as necessary to give continued protection at the time of application.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place.

DISPOSAL: Do not re-wrap and PRECAUTIONARY HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION

Do not contaminate feed or horses intended for food. Rinse cover fish aquariums before use.

ENVIRONMENT

This product is toxic to fish in streams or ponds. Do not clean equipment or dishes with this product only as specified.

STATEMENT OF F

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if necessary.

If In Eyes: Flush eyes with water for 15 minutes. Contact a physician if necessary.

If On Skin: Remove clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
