Especially developed for use on horses. Provides a protective hair coating against flies while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out. 1-2 ounces per head per day gives adequate protection. Apply by either soft cloth or fine mist spray.

**For Use As a spray:** Apply in a fine mist or fog. Use one to two ounces per animal per day. Also treat adjacent stable areas for more effective fly control. Do not wet the animal's skin. After application, brush the coat to give overall coverage. Make sure that legs and ankles are treated. For face area treat as a wipe-on application.

**To wipe on:** Rub the animal down and remove dirt. Pour a small amount (1 ounce) into a soft cloth and wipe on against the hair grain. Make sure to treat legs, belly, the neck and the facial areas as well as the back line. Do not wet skin. After this application, brush the coat to bring out a bright sheen. Repeat as needed to kill and repel biting flies. During fly time best protection will be given by treating animals 3 to 4 times each week.
