

FLEAS: DOGS AND CATS

Liberaly apply powder to the animal. Rubbing thoroughly to the skin and include the underbody, legs, feet and the base of the tail. Repeat application as necessary. Surfaces of kennels should be dusted at the rate of one ounce per 500 square feet. Infested lawns, basements, and crawl spaces should be dusted at the rate of 1000 square feet. Repeat as necessary. "Do NOT treat kittens and puppies less than four weeks old."

SOY BEANS, MILLBUGS, GROUND BEETLES, EARWIGS, MILLIPEDES AND SCORPIONS:

Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests enter. Treat baseboards, storage areas and other locations where these pests hide.


