The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act removing the active ingredient, MGK R-11 and increasing the amount of another active ingredient is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1) Submit a 1 year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and for one year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those which will be used in the trade. This study must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this letter.
- 2) The flash point reported exceeds the one expected for this product. Please check and resubmit. Mixtures marketed under pressure, including those containing hydrocarbons, are subject in their entirety to tests indicated in 40 CFR Sec. 156.10(h)(2)(iii) of the maxi-package. (Flash points for pressurized liquids are conveniently measured after collecting the expelled liquid from the container in an open cup chilled with dry ice. See Aerosol Guide, CSMA) Submit the flashpoint of the product with the propellant or change the word "Flammable" in the Physical or Chemical Hazards section of the label to read "Extremely Flammable."
