**To Repel the Insects Listed on the Front Panel: Remove protective cap. Apply
to all exposed skin areas. Repeat as needed. For ticks and chiggers, also
apply liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing.**

**Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young
children. Do not apply roll-on directly on face.**
