The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- 1. Your product is citing Evercide Intermediate 2412 (EPA Registration No. 1021-1542) for acute toxicity data. Evercide Intermediate 2412 is graded Toxicity Category II for Eye Irritation. Therefore the IF IN EYES statement should be placed first in the Statement of Practical Treatment.
- 2. Revise Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals as follows:

"Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contamination of ... "

- 3. Under Physical or Chemical Hazards delete FLAMMABLE. Your product contains nearly 90% water.
- 4. Under Environmental Hazards the statement should read as follows: "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."
