The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted. A copy of your proposed labeling stamped "ACCEPTED WITH COMMENTS" is enclosed.

WHAT THIS ACCEPTANCE MEANS:

Based on your certification, the Agency has accepted the labeling changes that are necessary to comply with the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) labeling requirements of 40 CFR part 156, subpart K, described in PR Notices 93-7 and 93-11. 

**Dust at a rate of 10 to 20 pounds per acre or 2 ounces to each 50 feet of row
in the garden. On flowers and shrubs, dust the entire plant thoroughly.
Repeat applications as necessary for effective control. When insect
infestation is heavy, applications are usually necessary at weekly intervals.
To control Mexican Bean Beetles, direct the material to the underside of the
leaves. NOTE: This product can be applied to vegetables up to within 1 day
of harvest.**

DOGS AND CATS

To Control Fleas: Dust powder liberally over the entire body. Rub dust into hair and around the feet, pads and between the toes so that they are well treated. Take care not to get the powder in animal's eyes, nose or mouth. Dust bedding, kennel and sleeping area regularly. Repeat as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash.
