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c. Delete cockroaches, silverfish and spiders since you have chosen to delete claims under General Surface Spray that appeared on previous labeling.

d. Under Dogs Sleeping Quarters, delete the sentence "If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present spray lightly into the air." This product is not for use as a space spray.

e. For clarity, the statement should read "The pets bedding areas should be sprayed. Spray old bedding or replace with fresh bedding."

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Ready to use. No mixing necessary. This water-base formulation may be applied directly with trigger spray applicator or as a wipe-on.

Kills fleas, ticks and lice on dogs. Also repels and controls house flies, stable flies, horn flies, face flies, horse flies, deer flies, mosquitoes and gnats. Kills fleas, ticks, cockroaches, silverfish and spiders around premises. Repels flies, mosquitoes and gnats for 3-5 days on horses.

DOGS

Cover animals eyes with hands. With a firm stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose, and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed. Controls fleas, ticks and lice on dogs and provides up to 28 days protection from reinfestation.

DOGS SLEEPING QUARTERS

Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats, or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The pet's bedding should be sprayed. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding.

HORSES AND PONIES

USE AS A WIPE ON: First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulders, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies most often are seen. Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your horses. Do not wet skin. After application, brush thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat. Repeat as required.

USE AS A SPRAY: Apply to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by flies. Do not wet horse's skin or exceed two ounces per application. After application, brush thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat. Repeat treatment as needed.

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STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area above 32oF and protect from freezing.

Disposal: Do not re-use container. Wrap and put in trash.

Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a Physician if irritation persists.
