

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration and the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of CFR Part 11. Contains petroleum distillate. If swallowed do not induce vomiting. Get immediate medical attention. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

Do not apply directly to food. Do not apply space spray while food processing is underway. Carefully clean all food processing surfaces. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After spraying in meat packing plants, bakeries, and the food processing plants, wash with an acceptable detergent solution and rinse with potable water to remove all traces of contamination on the equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled.

When using in animal housing areas, do not apply directly to food, water or feed supplements. Do not apply directly to animals. Wash teats of dairy animals before milking.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**GENERAL:** This product is designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers which produce particles of aerosol size, such as the LECO or MICRO-GEN.

**NOTE:** When used in hospitals, patients should be removed prior to treatment. Ventilate for two hours after treatment. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

**FOR USE IN HOMES, RESTAURANTS, FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS AND OTHER INDUSTRIAL AREAS:** Space Spray - Diluted: To Kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Small Flying Moths: Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Using a cold fog generator, apply at the rate of one-half (.5) ounce per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upwards toward upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Repeat as necessary.

Space Spray - Diluted for Ordinary Mechanical Fogging Equipment - To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Dilute Concentrate with refined kerosene at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 9 parts of refined kerosene and mix well. Apply at the rate of 50 fl. oz. of dilute spray (.4 gal.) per 25,000 cu. ft. of space. Direct fog upward towards upper corners of room and ceiling areas. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry.

Contact Spray - Undiluted - To Kill Cockroaches, German Weevils, Sawtoothed Grain Weevils, Corn Meal Weevils, Rice Weevils, Grain Weevils, Indian Meal Moths, and Flour Beetles: Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Using a cold fog generator, apply at the rate of one ounce per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Direct fog into areas suspected of harbouring these pests. Particular attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces, under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. Spray until treated surfaces are moist with deposit. Leave room closed for one-half hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Repeat as necessary.

Contact Spray - Diluted for Use with Sprayers that produce Wetting Spray Particles to Kill Cockroaches and Adults and Larvae of Grainary Insects: Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils, Grain Weevils, Indian Meal Moths, Flour Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Indian Meal Moth Larvae and Adults, Sawtoothed Grain Weevils, and Grain Mites: Cover or remove exposed food and food handling equipment. Apply fog and dilute Concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 9 parts of oil and mix well. Spray outside walls of grain bins, filling, and base of milling machinery, walls and baseboards, areas behind cabinets, around pipes and other insect harbourages using 1 gal. of spray per 1,000 sq. ft. of surface. Force spray into all cracks and crevices. Repeat applications as necessary.

**FOR USE IN DAIRY AND BEEF CANS, SWINE HOUSING:** Space Spray - Diluted for Use in Aerosol Generators to Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths and Exposed Cockroaches: Cover or remove exposed food and watering troughs and close house as tightly as possible. Dilute Concentrate with refined kerosene at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 1 part oil and mix well. Direct spray upward and apply until room is filled with mist. Keep closed for one-half hour and ventilate thoroughly prior to reentry.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE CONTINUED

Space Spray - Diluted for Ordinary Mechanical Fogging Equipment to Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Prepare for application as above. Dilute Concentrate with refined kerosene at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 9 parts of refined kerosene and mix well. Apply at the rate of 50 fl. oz. dilute spray (0.4 gal.) per 25,000 cu. ft. of space above animals. Direct fog upward toward upper corners of room and ceiling. Vacate room and leave closed for one-half hour.

**NOTE:** This spray, when diluted properly as described, and applied per the directions and cautions given above, conforms with Food Additive Regulations 121.1074, 121.1075 and 121.1205 and the food additive tolerances established thereunder. Additionally, when diluted and used according to label directions, this spray will meet specifications for use under USDA poultry, meat, rabbit and egg products inspection program.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State and Local procedures.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and Local procedures.

Containers one gallon or less:

Do not reuse container. Wrap and discard in trash.
