HORSES AND PONIES

For control of biting or sucking lice, ticks, flies and gnats  
on horses and ponies, dust directly onto all parts of  
animal's body. Work in dust by brushing against the lay of  
the hair to bring dust into contact with the skin. For best  
results give special attention to neck, mane, tail and  
flanks. Repeat as necessary, but not more often than once a  
week.

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### BARN AND STABLES

Apply to floor areas where manure accumulates, to control fly larvae and flies in the stable area.

### DOGS AND CATS

For control of fleas, ticks and lice on dogs and cats, apply powder liberally to body. Work in dust by brushing against the lay of the hair, allowing dust to penetrate to the skin. For best results give special attention to areas where hair is long and thick. Repeat as necessary but not more often than once a week. Do not treat puppies or kittens less than four weeks of age. For kennels and animal quarters, dust bedding and floors to prevent reinfestation.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and discard in trash.

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This container is filled by weight, not by volume. You can be assured of the proper weight even though some settling of contents normally occurs during transportation and handling.
