c. Based on the small quantity of petroleum distillates in the product formulation, the statement "Contains petroleum distillate" is not required on the product labeling. Further, the Precautionary Statements and Statement of Practical Treatment (If Swallowed) should be revised with respect to the comments concerning petroleum distillates.

Thus, you may delete "Contains petroleum distillate. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration pneumonia hazard." from the Precautionary Statements and revise the If Swallowed section as follows:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

d. Under Precautionary Statements change "Harmful if swallowed" to "Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin...."

To control listed insects, apply the spray to provide thorough coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat treatment weekly or as needed throughout the growing season up to days of harvest given for each crop.

FOR OUTDOOR PESTS: Mix concentrate in a compressed air sprayer or watering can at the rate of 16 fluid ounces per gallon of water to control on contact, ants, cockroaches (including German and Asian cockroaches), crickets, palmetto bugs, sowbugs, spiders, and ticks. Use at the rate of 1 gallon (diluted spray) per 1,000 square feet to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios, garages and other areas where these pests have been seen or are found. Do not spray in or near fish ponds or other bodies of water. Do not allow spray to contact ornamental plants or shrubs because of possible injury.

BUILDING PERIMETER TREATMENT: To help prevent infestations of buildings by ants, centipedes, crickets, sowbugs (pillbugs), and spiders, treat a 12-18 inch band of soil or other substrate adjacent to buildings and the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where these pests are active and may find entrance. Use 16 fluid ounces of concentrate per gallon of water and apply as a coarse wet spray at the rate of 1 gallon per 1,000 square feet.

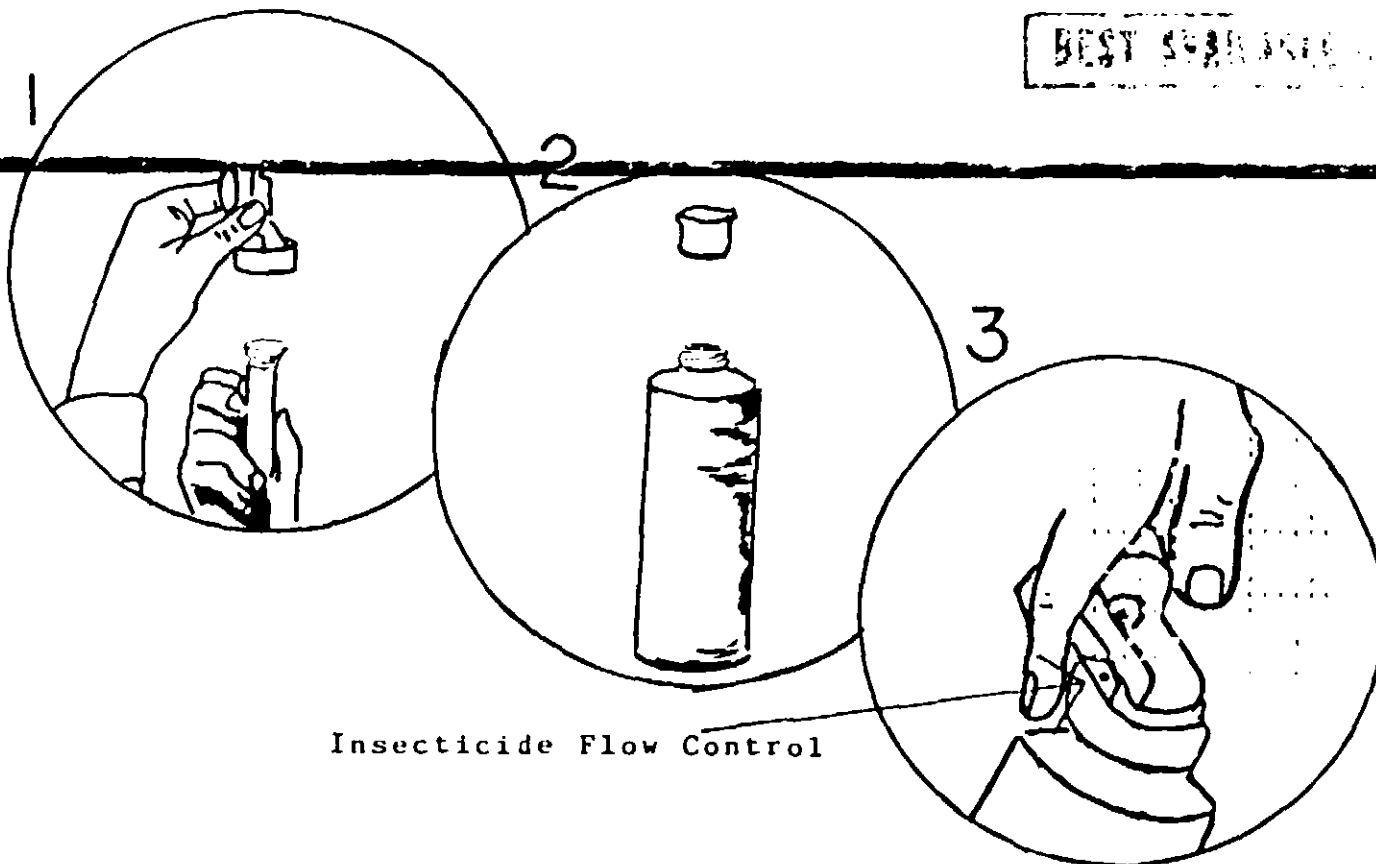

FOR USE WITH HOSE END SPRAYER CAP

The hose end sprayer cap is calibrated to deliver the correct dilution rate. No mixing - no measuring - no mess. Screw hose into back of sprayer cap. Remove bottle cap (save for storage after use). Secure sprayer cap by turning bottle counter-clockwise. Turn on water supply. TO START FLOW OF INSECTICIDE, place index finger over hole on right side of sprayer cap. Spray evenly and completely over infested areas.

Hold about three feet above surface, moving at a steady pace to insure consistent, thorough coverage. When treatment is complete, or you wish TO STOP FLOW OF INSECTICIDE for any reason, simply remove finger from hole to break siphon action. TO STORE REMAINING INSECTICIDE: turn off water supply and remove bottle from sprayer unit and hose by turning bottle clockwise. Replace cap on bottle and tighten securely. Unscrew hose from sprayer unit and rinse unit in clear water. Store in cool place.
