
- C) Since your data matrix does not include a dielectrical breakdown voltage the statement "Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard" must appear on the label.
- D) A 1 year storage stability study must be submitted. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those which will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this notice.
- E) This is being accepted as the basic formulation not as an alternate. Submit a revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) with the correct block checked and all items completed including item 17.

HOLD BOTTLE IN UPRIGHT POSITION WHEN SPRAYING

CATS and DOGS

Cover animal's eyes with hands and with a firm stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips rub into face around mouth, nose, and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long-haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat treatment as needed.

PUPPIES and KITTENS

Treat same as cats and dogs except nursing puppies and kittens. Spray only along back or on your fingertips and rub in with your fingertips.

PETS SLEEPING QUARTERS

Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The pet's bedding should be sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is sprayed too. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with a registered Flea and Tick Control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

HORSES

To control stable flies, horse flies and face flies, apply to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Repeat treatment as needed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT
