Dilute with water as below to give a 0.10% concentration and apply as a fine mist or fog. Direct spray toward the ceiling and upper corners of the room until the area is filled with mist, using about two (2) ounces per 1,000 cubic feet of space. For best results close doors and windows before spraying and keep them closed for ten to fifteen minutes after spraying. Ventilate the area before reoccupying. Repeat application as necessary.

FOR USE THROUGH AUTOMATIC SPRAYING SYSTEMS.

To kill Houseflies, Horn Flies, Stable Flies, Horse flies, Mosquitoes and gnats: Add concentrate to tank and add water to obtain desired dilution. Agitate well while adding water. Dispense diluted concentrate through automatic spraying system. Set nozzles to deliver one (1) ounce liquid per minute. Locate nozzles to cover a maximum of 2,000 cubic feet of space per nozzle. Set timer to operate in accordance with equipment directions.

Dilute spray just prior to use as follows:

0.10% Pyrethrins - Add 1 part Concentrate to 29 parts water.

0.50% Pyrethrins - Add 1 part Concentrate to 5 parts water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be used on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer... for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose off in a sanitary landfill or by other approved State and local procedures.

Containers one gallon or less:
