The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended label.

1. Change the "Precautionary Statements" to read:

Precautionary Statements
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
Avoid inhalation of spray mist. Avoid
contact with eyes and skin.

2. Include a "Physical and Chemical Hazard" heading to be placed above the word "Flammable".

3. Include a "Storage and Disposal" heading to be placed above the statement beginning with "Not to be refilled....."

The revised Confidential Statements of Formula for the alternate formulation dated October 31, 1995 are in compliance with PR Notice 91-2, agree with the label and are acceptable.

The chemical identities of the two fragrances listed on the CSF have been accepted for use in this product's pesticide formulations.


