HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed (inhaled or absorbed through the skin). Avoid breathing vapors [dust or spray mist]. Avoid contact with skin [eyes or clothing]. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Wear a long-sleeve shirt, long pants, and chemical resistant gloves at all times when mixing, loading, handling, or applying this chemical.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by rouching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF SPLASHED IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water and get medical attention.

IF SPILLED ON SKIN: Immediately remove contaminated clothing.

INCLUDING SHOES, and wash skin with soap and plenty of water.

If irritation develops, send for a physician.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Birds and other wildlife in treated areas may be killed. Do not apply directly to streams, lakes or ponds. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or public water unless this product is specifically identified and addressed in the NPDES permit. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewer treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

S T O R A G E A N D D I S P O S A L

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage. Storage should be under lock and key and secured from unauthorized persons and children. Storage area away from any heat or ignition source. Store on pallets high. Move bags carefully so as not to damage. Do not move containers from one area to another unless sealed. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Do not allow material to become wet or store in a damp, humid area. Avoid any puncture source. Avoid storage near water. Do not store fertilizer to avoid contamination. Store in a cool, dry place. If the contents are leaking or material is spilled, follow the following instructions:

1. Collect and place in suitable containers.
2. Wash area with water and soap to remove residue.
3. Follow washing with clean water rinse.
4. Do not allow run off to enter sewer or water source.
5. Dispose of waste as indicated below.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Do not mix excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate with other materials. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use of the above instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Protection Agency, the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Fiber drums with liners should be emptied by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to dislodge empty residue into applications equipment. Empty residue should be disposed of at a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be emptied in the same manner. Paper and plastic bags-Containers should be disposed of by incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities. If burned, stay out of smoke.
