**HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and clothing.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Applicators and other handlers must wear:

- Long sleeved shirt and long pants
- Waterproof gloves
- Shoes plus socks

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

When handlers use closed systems, enclosed cabs, or a aircraft in a manner that meets the requirements listed in the Worker Protection Standard (WPS) for agricultural pesticides [40 CFR 170.240 (d) (4-6)], the handler PPE requirements may be reduced or modified as specified in the WPS.

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS

Users should:

- Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply where weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL USE INFORMATION

IMMATURITY AND DROUGHT OF PLANTS ARE THE MOST FREQUENT CAUSES OF UNSATISFACTORY DEFOLIATION: Under most growing conditions proper maturity is indicated by the green foliage color becoming lighter and tinged with red, and by a definite reddening of the stems. Do not defoliate when plants are suffering from drought as evidenced by wilt condition of the plant. Cotton suffering from alkali soil condition should not be defoliated. Thorough coverage of the plant is essential, whether applied by ground or air. Apply defoliant 10-21 days before picking date on cotton.

FOR AIRCRAFT: Add sufficient water to equal a minimum of 5 gallons of spray per acre.

COTTON SPRAYERS: Use recommended amount of PickQuik Liquid Defoliant in 20 to 60 gallons of water per acre for cotton.

COTTON: Apply 2 to 2½ gallons per acre by ground sprayer or aircraft. For pre-harvest defoliation and desiccation, six to eight nozzles per row are usually necessary to obtain good results with ground sprayer. Do not graze treated areas or feed grain waste to livestock. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest.

MILO, SORGHUM: 2-3 gallons per acre for harvest desiccation. Apply when full mature, 7 to 10 days before harvest.

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
