Directions For Use

Use Compound X in the following manner:

Compound X is a water-soluble powder which can be used in a variety of ways. It can be used as a disinfectant, a sanitizer, and a preservative. It can also be used as a detergent for the removal of dirt and stains from fabrics and other materials.

The compound is provided in the powder form. Use 10 grams of Compound X per gallon of anti-foulant paint. Empty the powder into the paint and thoroughly mix before application. Use a power mixer when possible to obtain uniform dispersion. Keep compound tightly capped to keep out moisture.

Precautionary Statement

HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION: Repeated uses of Compound X and Compound X containing paints can induce resistance to antibiotic therapy. This resistance could lead to decreased antibiotic responsiveness during such therapy. User should minimize exposure by all appropriate means including the following: Limit applications to lowest needed to achieve results intended. Use protective clothing and respirator when making repeated and numerous applications. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

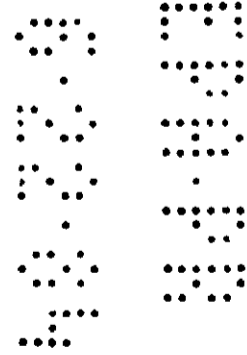

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

In the ingredient statement, add "(Equivalent to 20% oxytetracycline base)" as a substatement to the declaration of oxytetracycline hydrochloride. This will then be consistent with the Pfizer product you are repackaging.

Reinstate - The compound should not be brought in contact with water prior to mixing so that there will be an even distribution in the oil based bottom paint.

We believe the claim - COMPOUND X
ANTI-FOULANT
ADDITIVE

clearly establishes that this product is not for human medicinal or veterinarian use. The directions for use also reinforce the point. You may, however, add a statement to the label such as "not for treatment of human or animal diseases" if you wish.

Add the complete registration number to the label.

It is understood that the new formula and label ingredient statement will be used for all shipments of this product as of the acceptance date on the enclosed label.
