DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner incon-
sistent with its labeling.

CTT-6500 is used to control algae and bacteria
in recirculating commercial and industrial water cooling towers. Prior to its use,
systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth, microbiological slime, and
other deposits. An initial slug addition of 5.1 to 10.2 fluid ounces of
CTT-6500 per 1000 gallons of water is recom-
mended. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident.

Subsequent slug additions of 1.7 to 10.2 fluid ounces of
CTT-6500 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed
every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the
relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the microbiological problem. Slug
additions should be made in the sump of water cooling towers.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Do not stack more than
five drums high. Drums should be opened in well-ventilated areas. Leaking or
damaged drums should be placed in overpack drums for disposal. Spills should
be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a sanitary landfill. Keep con-
tainer closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of ex-
cess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these
wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your
