MAXI-KILL

In swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and indoor effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and hot tubs with heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using.

For pools having just visible algae growth add initially MAXI-KILL fluid ounces of

move settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a pool add initially 6 to 11 fluid ounces

per 10,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of MAXI-KILL per 10,000 gallons

7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, and decorative fountains require an initial dose of 1 to 2 fluid ounces

per 1,000 gallons of water. For treatment of a fresh hot tub, or decorative fountain, add initially MAXI-KILL per 1,000

gallons of 0.2 to 0.4 fluid ounces of MAXI-KILL should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment.

MAXI-KILL is commonly used to treat pools, spas, and decorative fountains with an alkaline pH. MAXI-KILL

decorative fountains treated with chlorine chemicals normally required. However, do not mix with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep container closed when not in use. Containers should be placed in a plastic bag and with clear water. All pesticides should be kept away from food.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container.
