Your letter and revised labels of November 23, 1996

Your letter indicated that no changes had been made to your labeling other than those provided in our Notice of Registration dated August 15, 1995. Normally, we do not review "final printed labeling". However, we did note a number of deviations from the approved labels. Therefore, we have commented on the revised labeling. Our comments reflect our recognition that your container necessarily is of a relatively small size.

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy to us before you ship your product:

1. Put the "*" after "Capsaicin and Related Capsaicinoids" because both are derived from the Oleoresin.
2. If you place any of your precautionary statements on the Back Panel, you must use the following two (2) headings:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

3. To be consistent, you need to **highlight** the following heading:

Physical or Chemical Hazards:

4. Revise formatting of "Storage and Disposal" statement as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL


Storage: Store only in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: When empty, replace cap. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
