Dear Mr. McGowan:

We have received the above revised labeling submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended. The results of our review of these documents follow. The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes on both labels and submit one (1) copy of each to us before you ship product:

1. Add to the front panel (Fig. 1) "See back panel for additional precautionary statements."
2. Add to the front panel (Fig. 1) "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" centered above "DANGER...damage if."

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

✓ Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals: See Front Panel.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Disposal: When empty, replace cap. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash. DO NOT INCINERATE OR PUNCTURE.
