**USE DIRECTIONS:**

Use at 2 ounces (1/4 cup) per gallon. This product will be effective against Pseudomonas aeruginosa PRD-10 at this level. This has been substantiated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test. At this level, the product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi.

For best results, use PEAK NO. 215 with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces.

When used for sanitization of food equipment or food contact items, limit the level of active quaternary to 200 ppm (2.8 ounces (1/2 cup) per 5 gallons). At this level a potable water rinse is required.

For heavy soil or organic matter, a precleaning step is recommended.
