Your Amendment Application Dated October 27, 1986

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. The sanitizing rinse claims must be grouped together and be separated from the disinfecting claims. For example, add the heading FOR SANITIZING to the second paragraph, left panel. This introduction should be followed by the Food Processing Equipment, Dairies, Restaurant, and Bar Rinse instructions. Also, a heading FOR DISINFECTION should occur before the Household, Hospitals, and Cold Disinfection instructions.
 - b. Expand the Disinfecting instructions to include a contact time of at least 10 minutes.
 - c. Under the heading Household, delete the term, "sanitizing" in the first sentence. Also, replace the word "Sanitize" in the third sentence with the word "Disinfect."
 - d. The statement ONLY FOR SALE TO, USE AND STORAGE BY SERVICE PERSONNEL must be deleted. Delete or replace the word Household with an nonresidential use area. If the word Household is retained on the label, a child-resistant packaging certification must be submitted (see enclosure).

USE DIRECTIONS:

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Pre-scrape or pre-soak if necessary. A thorough washing of area with a good detergent followed by a potable water wash before sanitizing is required. Provide a contact time of at least 1 minute, let surfaces dry. Fresh solution should be prepared daily with manual operation. See other side panel for specific use directions.

DANGER

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, flush eyes and skin immediately with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
