For a new pool, add 500 lbs. of sodium hypochlorite to the pool. For a pool in use, add 1 lb. of sodium hypochlorite per 10,000 gallons of water. For Pool Maintenance:
A) Adjust pH to 7.2-7.6.
B) Add 1 lb. of sodium hypochlorite per 10,000 gallons of water. The amount of water will provide additional sanitizing to the pool. Add 1 lb. of sodium hypochlorite per 10,000 gallons of water to maintain the pool's chlorine level.

FOR USE:
Dilute this solution by pouring solution to 11 parts, stirring thoroughly and begin feeding. Maintain a free available chlorine (FAC) throughout the day. Check water to verify with a test kit. Do not use if any that presented by the label. Check water to verify with a test kit.

DIRECTIONS:
Clean equipment in the pool thoroughly with this sodium hypochlorite. Mix one part to one part water. Soak equipment for 24 hours. Rinse thoroughly with water. **NOTE:** This product does not damage, as necessary, in all cases. **STORAGE AND HANDLING:** Store in a cool, dry place. Keep away from direct sunlight. In case of fire, use water to extinguish. Do not use in areas that cannot be used as a sanitary sewer. Do not clean equipment.
